

Day 1, Arrive Toronto

The biggest (and loudest) falls in North America, an incredible 750,000 gallons of water thunder into the gorge below every second, creating a natural phenomenon many have dubbed the 8th Wonder of the World. Day 3, Toronto - Kingston - Ottawa
